A group of volunteers work together to try lower the speed limit of vehicles through the village – would you like to join us?

It involves 3 volunteers at any one time standing by the roadside and measuring the speed of vehicles coming through the village, with the aid of a camera. The figures recorded are sent to the police with anyone who has been speeding sent a letter. If anyone is caught twice, they receive a visit from the police. We stand for one hour at a time and we aim to do this once or twice a week at varying times of the day, depending on availability from the monthly rota.

High-viz jackets are worn, and we work under the auspices of the police. They support us in every way possible. Every volunteer is trained but it is very simple, and a comprehensive handbook must be read by each volunteer.

Occasionally the police join the group with their own camera.
